Trenton Police Catch Downtown Burglar

During the early morning hours of April 28, 2007, while checking businesses, Lieutenant Dusty Vickers of the Trenton Police Department observed a male subject inside the BP station located on the Court Square.

Lieutenant Vickers approached the business, as the subject inside was exiting the building through a broken window. Lieutenant Vickers was assisted by Sergeant Ron Bennett and patrol officers Tony Harrison, Jennifer Tipton and Will Williams.

The officers identified the suspect as being Steve Williams. Steve Williams was able to elude officer but was apprehended later in the afternoon.

Steve Williams, 35 years of age, who listed an address of 310 Hillsboro Street in Trenton has been charged in the Trenton Municipal Court with Burglary and Evading Arrest. His bond was set at \$150,000.00 and remained in the Gibson County Correctional Complex at the time of this news release

Chief of Police Will Sanders told the Gazette that investigator suspected Steve Williams was responsible for several of the business burglaries in the downtown area since October of 2006. He said investigators are looking at several of the burglaries in the past in an effort to connect them to Steve Williams.
